It may be a coincidence, club leaders, but 30 (45%) of the clubs in our district have fewer than twenty members. The minimum number needed to start a Lions Club is 20 members. Almost half of the clubs in our district have fewer members than a brand new club has to have. In fact, 18 (over 25%) of the clubs in our district have fewer than 15 members! Lions sitting in Club Membership Chairs, lets invite a sight professional to your September meeting, enroll this sight professional at your October meeting. If you would like me, the 2nd VDG, the Governor, a Past District Governor or any member of district leadership to come to your club to induct this new member, I have no doubt they will. I know I will. Does your club have a brochure that tells what your club does in your community, what the district does for the families in southeast Pennsylvania? Do you have membership applications? Can you and your fellow Lions give them to your neighbors when you are collecting on White Cane Day? So many times at White Cane Day sites, people have told me, "My (father, uncle, grandfather) was a Lion." If people tell you that, too, do what I do: Hand them a brochure and ask them, "Would you like to be a Lion?" So, welcome to invigorating Autumn and to September when Lions begin to get active in the community. Presidents, plan a dynamic, active, visible community project for your club. Secretaries, file an Activity Report in September. Club Membership Chairpersons, encourage and invigorate the members of your club to identify a vision professional in your community and invite him, her; or, them to your September meeting.
